NOTIFICATION OF ESSENTIAL MAINTENANCE WORKS

A5 Towcester High Street

I am writing to let you know that we will be carrying out essential maintenance work on the A5 from the road bridge over the River Tove southwards towards the junction of the A5 with Marlow Road, Towcester.

Works to be carried out include drainage, kerbing, some footway resurfacing, carriageway resurfacing, road marking and the installation of road studs and traffic loops.

The work will also include the reinstatement of a trench over a gas main that runs between the south side of the junction at Brackley and Northampton Roads and The Lindens.

Once this work is completed, all road users will benefit from improved road safety.

When will the work take place?

Work is due to start late in July 2018 and is due for completion early in November 2018. Please note that all our planned roadworks may be subject to change due to weather conditions or unforeseen circumstances.

To minimise inconvenience and disruption we will work between 7am until midnight Monday to Friday, 7am until 5pm Saturday and 8am until 4pm Sunday.

How will the work affect traffic?

To maintain a safe environment for our workforce and customers, we need to use a mixture of lane and road closures.

Lane closures with temporary signal control will be used for the works from the bridge over the River Tove down to and including the junction of the A5 with Brackley and Northampton Roads.

A full road closure will be required to complete all necessary tasks from the south side of the junction with Brackley and Northampton Roads to a point approximately 60 metres south of the junction of the A5 with Marlow Road.

During these closures we will

- put in place fully signed diversion routes, which have been agreed with the Local Authority
- make sure access is maintained to all properties

We apologise for any inconvenience caused and will do our very best to complete the work as quickly as possible, keeping disturbances and noise to a minimum.
