Towcester's 22nd Midsummer Music Festival, presented by the Rotary Club of Towcester, Towcester & District Lions Club and Towcester Town Council is hosted by the Mayor of Towcester and brings live music of all varieties to the heart of the town.

The festival is a community event, providing a platform for the musical talents of local primary and secondary schools, performing arts school, community choirs and orchestras, music students, brass bands, local artistes and more, including our regular headline act, the Lincoln Noel Jazz Trio.

The main event is organised by volunteers from the community and supports the Town Mayor's charities. Over the years, town centre pubs have joined in the festival atmosphere by putting on their own entertainment.

Tickets

Our website will be regularly updated with all the latest information and the full community programme as well as pub acts.

Tickets, starting from £2 per person, are on sale via the website, for all the community acts. Tickets may be sold on the door, subject to availability. Pub venues are free of charge or may charge a small charitable door entry fee. All venues welcome additional donations to the Town Mayor's charities.



In memory of Geoffrey Iley 24 September 1928 - 17 March 2024 Founder Towcester Midsummer Music Festival

Geoffrey became Mayor of Towcester in 2003 and with his beloved wife Loïs, devised many local events for charity. Inspired after visits to Figanières, a village in the south of France, that hosts a music festival, Geoffrey started Towcester Midsummer Music Festival. This has continued and is now an important part of our town's cultural life.

Geoffrey and Lois continued to attend, support and advocate for the Towcester Midsummer Music Festival throughout the years, and met many dear local friends there – in particular among the performers, jazz pianist and singer Lincoln Noel. Lincoln who was always kind enough to pay tribute to Geoffrey and his contributions to Towcester life whenever he performed at the event.

He leaves his wife Loïs, daughters Paula and Frances, sons Adrian and John, and stepsons, Jeremy and Simon.
