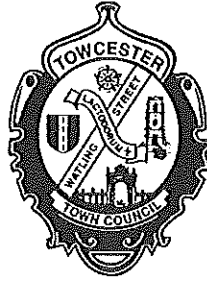

- Provide changing and showering facilities adjoining Towcester Recreation Ground


